Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The recent storms in Louisiana may not have a name, but the names of those suffering in the wake of the worst flooding since Hurricane Katrina are our brothers and sisters. As many as 60,000 homes have been damaged, with nearly 20,000 people being rescued from the flood waters. More than 106,000 individuals and families have sought federal disaster aid. Immediate and long-term recovery needs place a tremendous burden on public and private resources.

Archbishop Joseph Kurtz, president of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, has called for an emergency collection to support the humanitarian efforts of Catholic Charities USA to provide pastoral and rebuilding support to the flood victims of the Catholic dioceses impacted in Louisiana. As people of God, let us come to their aid with prayer and material support to help them rebuild lives.

Knowing your great generosity in the past, I thank you in advance for your response as our brothers and sisters urgently struggle to rebuild their lives and cling to the hope their faith gives them.

We represent the catholic faith in everything we do and therefore we take this commitment seriously. We have very strict guidelines we follow with no exceptions.


Over the past several months issues have occurred at your council. I addressed them with the council officers with no results. Lastly, I along with my state advocate came and met with the council which ended again with no results.
