Dear Father Latosynski,

Enclosed, please find the billing for the Ecclesial Province of Miami (EPM) Self- insurance Risk Management Program, including coverage for the period April 1, 2017 through March 31, 2018. For the Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee the total cost of the program for 2017-2018 is approximately \$2,389,000.

...Based on increased general liability and worker's compensation claims, our fund increased by \$89,000.

...For those locations that are in designated flood zones, premium for flood insurance continued their upwards trend as flood maps continue to be updated.

...As in the past, you may pay the entire invoice in full upon receipt or make two **payments with 50% due on each of May 15th and June 15th, 2017.**
